Remo has a degree in sculpture from ANU and a background in theatre - most noted for his work in a white tuxedo creating large-scale sculpture with a chainsaw!

Remo was director of ODD Productions from 1994 to 2002. His work with ODD focused on large-scale theatrical productions including set design. His work featured in The Canberra Festival of Contemporary Arts and the iconic Big Day Out from 1999 to 2002.

He designed and constructed rock sets for Bardot and Living End at the ARIA awards and produced large scale events and parties across the country, including Misty Bar and Gin Palace birthday parties, Red Raw and Sin parties for the ALSO Foundation, and Rock Pool and Earthcore at the Myer Music Bowl.

In 2002 Remo launched Gale & Vallance. Initially he assisted and collaborated with the iconic master of sculptural interiors, Nic Brunner, designing award winning interior fit outs for Brisbane's Lychee Lounge, Family Nightclub, Birdie Num Num and Bunk Backpackers.

Remo is now the head designer and fabricator on all Gale & Vallance projects. He delights in creating and contributing to design that is personal by leading his team of fabricators to bring a balance of fantasy, fun and function into G&V projects.
